Even though this has been changed to minOccurs- 0, it is still a mandatory field for all persons. It has only been changed to allow for no entry for non-person type victims.
3/31/21	Group B offense	Montana will continue to collect complete incident information for Group B offenses. For submission to the MT state repository there is no difference between a Group A and Group B offense. A single incident may have both Group A and Group B offenses. When a Group A and B offenses occur in the same incident, only the Group A offenses will be reported to the FBI. When an incident is reported that only contains Group B offenses, this information will only be reported to the FBI if there is an associated arrest.	Montana will collect all data elements (flat files segments 1 through 6) for all group B incidents, regardless of arrest. The MTIBRS repository will determine which offenses or combination of offenses are submitted to the FBI. Segment 7 has never been collected and will not be collected in XML. Montana will continue to collect complete incident information for Group B offenses. For submission to the MT state repository there is no difference between a Group A and Group B offense. A single incident may have both Group A and Group B offenses. When a Group A and B offenses occur in the same incident, the MTIBRS repository will report Group A offenses to the FBI. When an incident is reported that only contains Group B offenses, MTIBRS

			repository will only report to the FBI if there is an associated Group B arrest.
